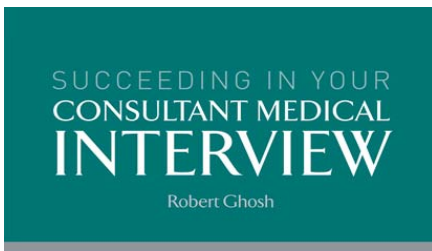


Book Information: Succeeding In Your Consultant Medical Interview
